INTRODUCTION

This Prospectus contains rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission for the academic year 2025-26 to College of Allied Health Sciences, Believers Church Medical College Hospital, against 50% seats of the sanctioned intake of BPT and other courses such as B.Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT), B.Sc. Optometry, and B.Sc. Cardiovascular Technology (BCVT) is in the process of obtaining affiliation.

This prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the college and subject to the Judgments of the Honorable Courts of law.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION **UG**

- i. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognized as equivalent there to, as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

- ii. Should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or an examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Should have a separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.
- iii. Students applying for admission should have studied English as a subject at the Higher Secondary level.

NUMBER OF SEATS AND DETAILS OF RESERVATION

The College is conducting allotment and admission to UG for 50% of the seats and the remaining 50% of the seats are filled up by the authority designated by the Government of Kerala, as the college has intimated its willingness to share the seats. Presently, we have 6 seats available for the BPT program, and other courses are currently in the process of obtaining affiliation.

- The institution has submitted its willingness to share 50% of the seats with the Govt. of Kerala.

RELAXATION IN MARKS:

For all the courses, candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (as per G.O. (P) No. 208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, G.O.(MS) No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 06.10.2008 and amendments thereof), will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. They need only 45% marks in the case of Biology where it is required separately and 45% marks in the case of optional subjects put together. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

The relaxation of marks in the qualifying examination extended to SEBC candidates only will be applicable to OEC candidates even if they are allotted against the unavailed seats of SC/ST quota. Also refer Clause 5.4.2(e). In respect of candidates, included in the PwD quota list published by the LBS Centre, the minimum marks required for admission shall be 5% less than that prescribed for the general category.

No rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is permitted. For example, a score of 50 marks out of 100 or 150 marks out of 300 alone will be considered as 50% marks and scores of 45 out of 100 or 135 out of 300 alone will be considered as 45% marks for determining eligibility. Candidates who have appeared for the Higher Secondary or equivalent examination will be permitted to submit the application. However, they should attain the prescribed qualification before the last date prescribed for submission of the application.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for admission to all the courses under Allied Health Sciences must be submitted online through a single application. The online application facility is available at www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will result in the rejection of their candidature.

- Eligibility / Equivalence Certificate obtained from Kerala University of Health Science by candidate who have passed qualifying examination from authorities other than the state of Kerala/ CBSE/ICSE
- Qualifying Examination Mark list and Degree Certificates where applicable
- Signature of the candidate.
- Allotment memo and fee receipt (LBS Students)
- Pay the prescribed fee by online payment.
- A formal receipt will be issued to your email address after payment.
- Submit the application and generate a PDF copy of the application. (No need to send the hard copy to our office).
- No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or documents after the closing date of the application. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.

Candidates selected for NRI quota

- The candidates selected for NRI quota have to submit the following documents also along with the above documents
- Sponsorship Certificate

- Copy of the passport of the sponsor attested by embassy
- The embassy attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped and if it is not submitted the employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy or consulate.

Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar

- *Relationship with the sponsor should comply with the Government order No.GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014,dated 12.06.2014.
- Selected candidates have to remit all the fees as mentioned above at the time of admission itself. The fee can be paid by RTGS/NEFT/DD/Net banking/Online banking. If the entire fee as mentioned above is not remitted within the time of admission, the application of the Candidate will be removed from the admission process.
- All the students should pay their fees for the subsequent years on or before 31st August of the respective years.
- If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course (4 yrs). Claim, if any, for liquidated damages against any student shall be determined by appropriate proceedings before the competent forum/civil court.

Application Fee

- The application fee will be Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) +18% GST for all candidates, payable through online. Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of the Application fee through online. It is not required to pay the application fee separately for each course.
- If the payment is debited and you are not guided to the next stage please inform us to website <https://bcmch.edu.in/allied-health-science> with your login details or email-id or mobile number, we will provide you the required help within 24 hours.
- The application fee, once remitted, will not be refunded in any circumstances.

1. Should have passed Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or an examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Should have a separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology put together.
2. Eligibility Certificates: Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from Schools/Boards outside Kerala State shall produce the certificate of recognition ie. Eligibility Certificate from KUHS Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of the interview for admission.

(B) Preparation of Merit List

1. The eligible candidates will be informed of an aptitude test and a selection interview by the institution.
2. Out of 50% management seats 35% seats will be filled by management from among the applications received and on the basis of merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria and Marks scored in aptitude test.
3. Out of 50% management seats (15% of total seats) NRI seats shall be filled up from qualified students as per G.O (MS) No.243/2014/HRFWD dated 6.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala. "An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife /Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister /Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad" will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats".
4. Procedure for Normalisation: The marks scored by the candidates in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in the Qualifying Examination conducted by various Boards will be made comparable with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the Directorate of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala. Accordingly a maximum of 5 % weightage will be given to the candidates qualified from CBSE and ICSE Boards.
5. Resolving of tie while ranking: In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in English (Plus two) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Biology (Plus two) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry (Plus two) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics (Plus two) will be placed higher in the ranking, If the tie still exists, the percentage of total marks for plus one and plus two together in the core subjects will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, tie will be resolved by a criteria as decided by the Dean/Principal/Head of the institution.

(C) Publication of Rank List.

1. Rank Lists will be published on the website <https://bcmch.edu.in/allied-health-science> on the date mentioned in the admission schedule furnished in the last page of this prospectus.

2. Validity of the Rank lists:-

The Rank lists for Allied Health Science Courses will be valid upto the cut-off date prescribed by the order of Government of Kerala /Kerala University of Health Sciences.

(D) ALLOTMENTS

1. There will be three online allotments as mentioned in the admission schedule.
2. The allotted candidates have to join the programme after the selection interview/verification of documents within 3 days of selection intimation, after paying the full fees for the programme. The admission of those students who do not take admission within the joining date will deem to be cancelled.
3. For those who have been selected after the selection interview and have not paid the college fee within the prescribed date, the admission will be summarily cancelled and seat will be allotted to the next eligible candidate. No further claim for admission will be entertained.
4. **Spot Allotment:** Spot allotment will be conducted based on the vacant seats, including Government lapsed seats available in the institutions. However, the date and place of spot allotment will be duly intimated through our website and leading newspapers after obtaining permission from AFRC.

(E) Selection and Verification of Documents:

1. The selected candidates will be intimated for a selection interview by the institution. The Principal/Head of the College or Institution shall be personally responsible for verification of original documents and satisfaction of the correctness of the records produced by the candidate.
2. Any mismatch in the marks and any other false information recorded in order to gain admission will be summarily rejected.

(F) General Information

1. The medium of instruction and examination shall be **English**.
2. Hostel accommodation is **optional and not compulsory**.
3. All Undergraduate programs are **affiliated with the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS)**.
4. The use of mobile phones by students is **strictly prohibited** in the campus, hospital, and hostels. Any violation will invite strict disciplinary action by the college authorities. However, students may use mobile phones during the **permitted time/day** in the hostel or campus.
5. Every student must **strictly follow the code of conduct** of the institution.
6. Detailed course regulations, eligibility for university examinations, maximum course duration, and related information can be obtained from the **KUHS website**: <http://www.kuhs.ac.in>.
7. Any matters not specifically addressed in this prospectus shall be decided by the **undersigned**, and such decisions will be **final and binding**.

(G) Special Instruction:-

1. Course Discontinuation/ Liquidated damage.

"If any candidate discontinues the course after the admission cut-off date notified by KUHS/Competent Authority, he/she shall be liable to comply with the clauses on liquidated damages as specified in the Government Prospectus, in order to obtain the certificates and Transfer Certificate (TC) from the institution.

(H) Prohibition of Ragging:

1. **Definition of Ragging:** As per the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998, 'ragging' refers to any act of disorderly conduct by a student that causes, or is likely to cause, physical or psychological harm, fear, shame, or embarrassment to another student. This includes teasing, abusing, playing pranks, causing hurt, or compelling a student to perform acts that they would not ordinarily agree to.
2. **Zero Tolerance Policy:** Ragging or any form of misconduct towards any student, whether on the college campus or outside, is considered a **criminal offense** and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will be **barred from continuing their studies**.
3. **Affidavit Requirement:** At the time of admission, both students and parents are required to submit an **affidavit** on the UGC Anti-Ragging portal https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit_affiliated_form.php and provide the **PDF/Application Number** to the college office.
4. Committed to abolishing ragging on campus. Hence, any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per the provisions of law. Also, the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per the Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regard.

The fee structure provided above for the academic year 2025–26 is proposed by the college and is subject to modification as per the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC), in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed by FRC. The fee may also be revised annually based on such regulations. Charges for hostel, mess, and transportation (bus) will be levied separately.

If the fee approved by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC) is lower than the fee proposed by the college, the excess amount already paid will be refunded to the students by the college. Conversely, if the fee fixed by FRC is higher than the proposed fee, students will be liable to remit the additional amount to the college. All fees will be collected strictly in accordance with the orders of FRC for the academic year 2025–26.

Apart from the schedule of fee given above, the students will be required to pay the proportionate administration / affiliation / examination fee, etc. payable to KUHS / DME or any other statutory authority from time to time. Hostel, Mess fee, and BUS fee will be charged separately.
